<b>ORDER GRANTING PETITIONER'S MOTION TO DETERMINE CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS</b>

**THIS CAUSE** came before the Honorable William Dorman without hearing, on the Petitioner's Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records. The Court having reviewed the file, and being fully advised in the premises and relevant authority, hereby **FINDS, ORDERS AND ADJUDGES:**

1. This is a domestic relations case and the Court is ordering the sealing of entire court file and progress docket, specified below, pursuant to Fla. R. Gen. Prac. & Jud. Admin. 2.420(c) in order to prevent serious and imminent threat to the fair, impartial, and orderly administration of justice, to avoid substantial injury by disclosure personal information of the parties.
2. Neither the name of Petitioner nor the name of Respondent is determined to be confidential.
3. There are no less restrictive measures available to the parties to protect their interests and the degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality sought is no broader than necessary to protect these interests.
4. No person other than the Court, the Petitioner, the Respondent, or counsel for either party shall be permitted to view the Confidential Records.
5. The Clerk shall immediately seal entire court file and progress docket. The confidential records shall not be made available on any public information system. The Clerk shall

ensure that only the parties, their present and future legal counsels and this Court, have the ability to view the exhibits that are to be sealed.

6. The Clerk is directed to post a copy of this Order on the Clerk's website and in a prominent public location in the Courthouse within 10 days of rendition of this Order. The Order must remain posted in both locations for no less than 30 days.
