The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the Glades County / US-27 Corridor Utility Study.

Glades County is evaluating the current availability and potential future needs for wastewater improvements along the 4-Mile segment of US-27 that extends from the City of Moore Haven to the Glades-Hendry boundary line.

The US-27 Corridor Utility Study is being developed by faculty from the Florida Gulf Coast University (FGCU), in partnership with Waldrop Engineering, and will provide recommendations to guide policy-making, long-range planning, and future investment decisions.

This open-house event was held to exchange ideas and gather input from land owners, residents, the business community, local representatives, and members of the public.
